Accompanied by a guide, you will discover the twin coastal towns of Cape Coast and Elmina, whose stunning beaches are home to the critical World Heritage Site monuments, the Cape Coast and St. George slave castles, two of the largest and best-preserved slave-holding fortress museums in West Africa. You will also visit Kakum National Park, the most extensive rainforest preserve in Ghana and site of Africa's first canopy walk: A series of tree-top walkways and platforms suspended 100 feet in the air that offers a true bird's eye view of the forest and its many wild inhabitants.

Tour Price: \$700 for single accommodation; \$500 for shared accommodation, includes hotel, breakfast, bus, entry fees and guide. The minimum number of attendees is 30; if there are not enough participants, we will refund in-full. No cancellation fee through Friday 11 March 2016.
